## BYLAW 298 A

A Bylaw of the Town Of Rainbow Lake, in the Province of Alberta, to provide for the appointment of chief elected official by Council from among the councilors and to provide for election of five council members.

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26.1, 1994, Part 5, Section 150, provides that a Council may pass a bylaw requiring Council to appoint the chief elected official from among the Councilors,

AND WHEREAS, the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26.1, 1994, Part 5 Section 143.2, provides that a Council may determine the number of Councilors to a minimum of five(5),

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the provisions of Sections 150 and of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26.1, 1994 the Council of the Town of Rainbow Lake, in the Province of Alberta, in Council duly assembled, enact as follows:

- That the Chief Elected Official of the Town of Rainbow Lake shall be appointed by Council from among the Councilors.
- That the appointment shall be made by Council at their Organizational Meeting to be held not later that two weeks after the third Monday in October.
- That the appointment shall be effective annually at the Organizational Meeting of Council.
- 4. That the number of Council Members elected, and serving on Council shall remain at Five (5)

This bylaw shall come into effect upon the date of final reading.
