**A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF RAINBOW LAKE, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTION OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TOWN OF RAINBOW LAKE AND THE MACKENZIE MUNICIPAL SERVICES AGENCY TO PROVIDE A SUBDIVISION AUTHORITY FOR THE TOWN OF RAINBOW LAKE.**

**Whereas,** Section 623 of the Municipal Government Act requires a council to provide for a subdivision authority to exercise subdivision powers and duties on behalf of the municipality, and

**Whereas,** Section 625 of the Municipal Government Act allows a municipality to delegate its subdivision authority powers, duties and functions to an inter-municipal service agency, and

**Whereas,** The Town of Rainbow Lake considers it beneficial to delegate the subdivision authority,

**Now Therefore,**

The council of the Town of Rainbow Lake in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. That the subdivision authority, including accepting, processing, decisions and endorsement of applications for subdivision, be delegated to the Mackenzie Municipal Services Agency.

**This bylaw shall come into effect upon the date of final reading.**
