BY-LAW NO. 95

A BY-LAW OF THE NEW TOWN OF RAINBOW LAKE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO PROVIDE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A MUNICIPAL LIBRARY

WHEREAS, the Board of Administrators of the New Town of Rainbow Lake deems it expedient to propose the establishment of a municipal library.

NOW THEREFORE with the authority and under the provisions of Part III of "The Libraries Act" and Amendments thereto, being Chapter 206 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1970, the Board of Administrators of the New Town of Rainbow Lake duly assembled enacts as follows:

- 1) There shall be established a municipal library for the New Town of Rainbow Lake.
- 2) The Municipal Library shall be managed, regulated and controlled by a Library Board.
- The policies of the Municipal Library Board shall be governed by Parts III and VII of "The Libraries Act" and amendments and Regulations pertaining thereto.
- 4) This By-Law shall take effect on the date of the final passing thereof.
