BYLAW NO. 2014-01

A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE THE RATES OF TAXATION LEVIED AGAINST ASSESSABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE TOWN OF RAINBOW LAKE FOR THE 2014 TAXATION YEAR.

Whereas, the Town of Rainbow Lake has prepared and adopted detailed estimates of the municipal revenues and expenditures as required, at the council meeting held on April 9, 2014; and

Whereas, the estimated municipal expenditures including requisitions and transfers set out in the budget for the Town of Rainbow Lake for 2014 total \$8,234,597; and

Whereas, the estimated municipal revenues and transfers from all sources other than taxation is estimated at \$6,902,261 and the balance of \$1,332,336 is to be raised by general municipal taxation; and
