4. If you want to fly away, or hear the mayor speak, or maybe pay your local bills, it's this building that you seek

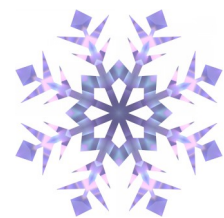
5. Lots of people, from every grade, come to this place, to learn each day

9. We love this town, home of yours and mine, here stands our mascot, on number nine

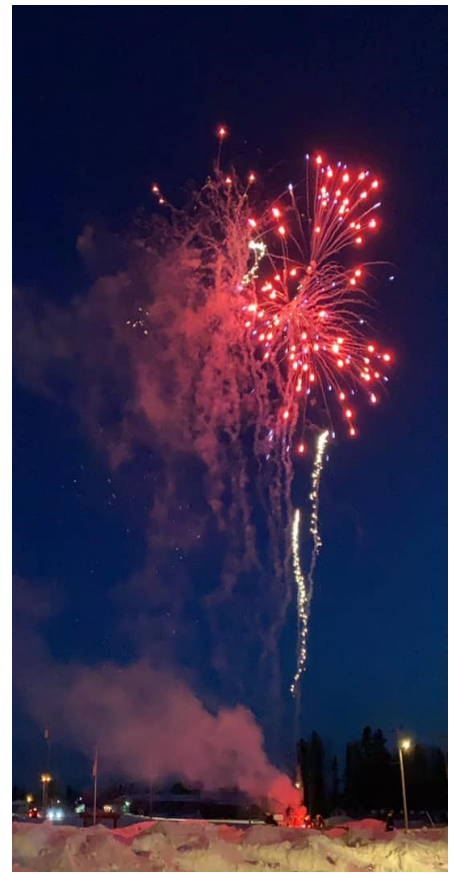


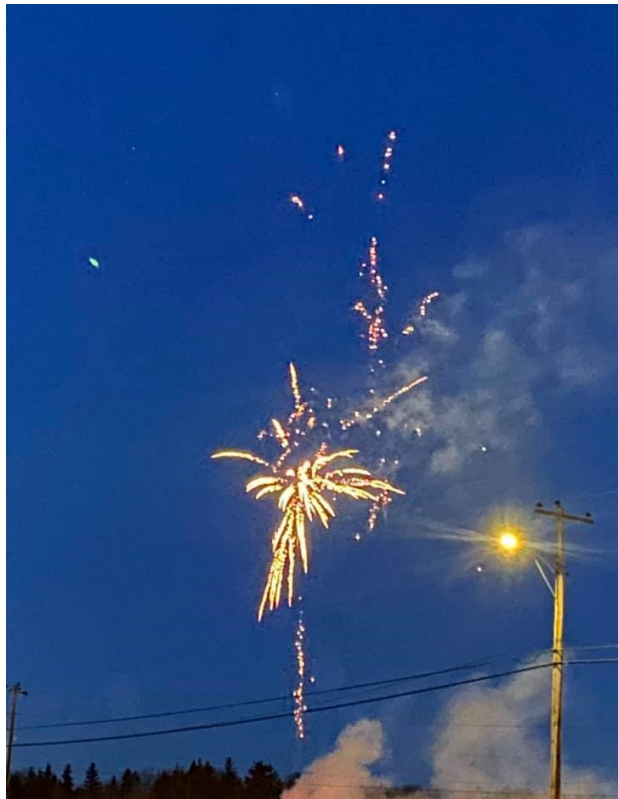

With the presence of a Lynx in town, we are urging everyone to take care while outside and also with their pets. Hopefully the Lynx will leave on it's own here soon enough, but until then, here are some tips if you happen to encounter the Lynx:

- Never approach the animal, especially if it's near a kill or with young.
- Do not run, a cat's instinct is to chase.
- If you're with others, stay together and act as a group.
- Face the animal and talk firmly while slowly backing away.
- Always leave the animal an escape route.
- Do not crouch down or try to hide, instead try to appear larger.
- Do not take your eyes off the animal or turn your back.



Please everyone, keep your distance and respect the wildlife in the area.
