**COVID RESITRICTIONS LIFITNG** 

Stage 3 begins on Canada Day in Alberta and marks the first day nearly all public health restrictions will be lifted, including the provincial mask mandate and full capacity at restaurants, bars, and retail outlets.

All restrictions lifted will include:

- The ban on indoor social gatherings.
- The general indoor provincial mask mandate will be lifted, but masking may still be required in limited and specific settings or if businesses still require masking.
- Recreational and health facilities will be fully opened
  - No more limits on weddings, funerals, and gyms
  - Sports and fitness activities can resume as normal
  - Non-essential travel no longer discouraged

Isolation requirements for confirmed cases of COVID-19 and some protective measures in continuing care settings will still remain in effect.

Some business may still have some protective
measures and controls in place. Please be
respectful to these establishments and we
hope everyone has a great summer!!!

## **Voyent Alert App**

This is just a reminder to anyone who hasn't downloaded the Voyent alert app yet on their phone. This app will allow the Town to send messages through the app directly to your phone in the event of an emergency. You can follow up to date information regarding the emergency situation and in the event that we need to evacuate it will let you know where to check in. This app will also let you mark your house as vacant in the event of an emergency so we can ensure the safety of all residents leaving town.

#### Emergency alerts and day-to-day notifications for the Town of Rainbow Lake



#### What You Can Expect

#### Personalized Communications

Voyent Alert! provides informative communications. Critical information such as the distance and direction from an incident, and preferred evacuation routes from your tracked locations may be provided.

#### **Track Multiple Locations**

Voyent Alert! allows you to create and track multiple locations such as "Kids School" or "Mom's House". Any event or communication related to your tracked locations will be forwarded to you along your preferred communication channel.

#### **Communications Your Way**

Receive alerts over a wide variety of communication channels including mobile apps, text/SMS alerting, email or voice dial. You can register for one or more communication channels.

#### **No Message Fatigue**

Smart alerting capabilities ensure that you will only get notified when a communication is relevant to you or one of the locations you are tracking.

#### Easy Registration

Registration for the service is FREE, simple and anonymous.

### **Emergency Horn**

Just a reminder that the emergency alert horn is blown daily at 6 pm Spring to Fall and 7 pm Fall to Spring. In the event of a real emergency, the horn will continue to sound every 30 seconds or so, and may be at different times of the day or night. Further instructions will follow by loud callers (bull horns), telephone (if available), cable/ internet (if available), Alberta Public Warning System, and door to door to ensure that everyone in town has been notified (if the emergency allows for persons to be outside). The type of notice and the instructions given will be determined by the type of emergency. Please stay put at your residence/workplace until the Emergency Operations Centre has an opportunity to advise you of the type of emergency that has occurred and the appropriate actions to ensure that you and your family are safe.



## **Cable Channels**

With the recent thunderstorm and power outage we experienced, a piece of cable equipment at the head end has failed. This has resulted in some cable channels not working. We have put in the request for a new piece of equipment to be shipped out to us and we are hoping that it arrives soon. We apologize for the inconvenience and will update once the channels are back up and running
