Maintenance Worker


The Town of Rainbow Lake is looking for mature, reliable hardworking summer students to fill positions for the summer months.

Summary: Reporting to the Public Works Foreman and the Director of Recreation & Facilities, Summer Maintenance Workers general responsibility is to keep all town green spaces clean and well maintained.

Qualifications:

- Minimum 15 years of age
- Current First aid and CPR certification are an asset
- Experience with lawn care equipment is an asset (will train on equipment)
- Be willing to work outside with machinery.



• Experience with painting, floor stripping & waxing, facility housekeeping, and working with cleaning supplies and cleaning equipment is an asset (will train on equipment and procedures)

*Any experience mentioned above is welcome, if limited in experience, our qualified staff will train on equipment and procedures, as necessary.

Responsibilities:

- Maintain ball diamond, tennis & basketball courts, and other sports related facilities: including lawn care of parks and town green spaces.
- Assist with park cleanup and garbage control within town limits.
- Assist in maintaining pathways, parking lots and public areas.
- Maintain grandpa Jack playground park.
- Maintain in and outside of Recreation Facility, this includes and not limited to; painting, floor stripping & waxing, window cleaning (arena), etc.
- Assist running of Canada Day events.

Water Project

The water line project that started last summer to replace valves, mains, and infrastructure, will be starting around June 3-5, 2021 and will last about 6 weeks. The areas that will be upgraded this summer will be Banff Ave and Pan Am Street. Costumers and properties that will be affected by the project will be notified in advance. Customers will notice a slight disruption in their water service when they are temporally hooked up to the main water line via hose connection. The hose connection will still allow water service to the property but the pressure might be decreased. Bear Safety

What to do if you see a bear

- Stay Calm. Your calm behavior can reassure the bear. Loud noises or sudden movements may trigger an attack
- Back away slowly and never run!! Running away may trigger a pursuit and for the bear to chase you
- Make yourself appear BIG. Pick up small children and stay in a group if your in one.
- Speak to the bear and talk calmly and firmly to it. This lets the bear know that you are human and not a prey animal. If the bear rears on its hind legs and waves its snout around, it is trying to identify you.

How can I keep bears out of my backyard?

- Keep your garbage and recyclables in bear resistant, airtight containers, or indoors
- Clean your BBQ. Scrub your BBQ clean after each use and if possible store it indoors
- Never leave food out for wildlife
- Keep your compost indoors. Outdoor compost attracts bears. Look into using an indoor composter
- Remove any apples or berries from your yard that may attract bears

If you see a bear please call Fish and Wildlife at 310-0000 and if you see a bear in a trap this summer, please be respectful and leave the bear alone. We don't want it more afraid than it probably is and we don't want to see anyone get hurt.
