Tax and Assessment Notice

The Property Taxation and Assessment notices for the Town of Rainbow Lake will be mailed out on May 10, 2021, to all property owners on the Assessment Roll for the Town of Rainbow Lake.

If you do not receive your Tax and Assessment Notice, or if your notice contains incorrect owner or mailing address information, please contact the Town Office at 780-956-3934 or admin@rainbowlake.ca

If you have any questions or concerns regarding the assessed value of your property, please contact the Town's Assessor Aaron Steblyk of Compass Assessment Cons Inc. at 780-469-5552 or aaron.steblyk@compassassessment.com

If speaking to the assessor does not resolve your concerns, you may appeal your assessment in writing. Assessment complaint forms are available at the Town Office and are also available on the Municipal Affairs website https:// www.alberta.ca/assets/documents/ma-property-assessment-compliancereview-form.pdf

On the complaint form, you **MUST** provide the reason(s) why you believe the information shown on the Assessment and Tax Notice is incorrect. Simply stating the assessed value is deemed to high will be insufficient, you will need to provide details as to why you believe the assessed value is greater than it should be.

Assessment complaint deadline is July 15, 2021

Your completed complaint form, together with the required complaint fee (\$50), must be received at the Town Office no later than 4:30pm on July 15, 2021 to be considered valid as per MGA section 461(1.1)

Federal Fuel Charge Increase

On April 1, 2021, federal taxes on greenhouse gas emissions increased from \$30 to \$40 per tonne. As a result the Federal Fuel Charge on natural gas increased from \$1.58/GJ to **\$2.1025899/GJ**.

Natural Gas Utilities are required to invoice the Federal Fuel Charge as per the federal Greenhouse Gas Pollution Pricing Act. All charges collected under this Act are remitted directly to Revenue Canada.

The new rate will be automatically applied to your bill for natural gas consumed beginning April 1, 2021.

As a result of the Federal gas increase, you will notice an increase to your carbon levy charges on your next utility bill.

Utility Rate Increase

The Town has changed a great deal over the past 6 years, and we have to look at what changes we must make to move with it. The Town has been steadily losing revenue in the Water, Sewer and Garbage utilities for several years now. This is due to the fact that we have less customers in town as people are moving away, and as such less revenue on our flat rate Water/Sewer/Garbage utility. We have been subsidizing with the Tax Revenue, but with a 30% drop in assessments in 2020, our tax revenue is no longer able to make up the difference. In order to maintain the services we provide, we have to ensure the utilities rates we levy, are covering the cost of providing the service.

The below chart highlights the current monthly cost for Water, Sewer and Garbage utilities, each month based on a usage of 10 cubic meters of water (our base rate). We have also provided comparison values from other Municipalities where we could easily derive a cost for the same service here in Rainbow Lake. With the new increase shown below, will move Rainbow Lake from almost the bottom of the list to the middle.

Water Line Project

The water line project that started last summer to replace valves, mains, and infrastructure, will continue into this summer. The areas that will be upgraded this summer will be Banff Ave, Mobil Ave, and Del Rio. Costumers and properties that will be affected by the project will be notified in advance. Customers will notice a slight disruption in their water service when they are temporally hooked up to the main water line via hose connection. The hose connection will still allow water service to the property but the pressure might be decreased.
