NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOVEMBER 1, 2021

PROPOSED LAND USE BYLAW NO. 2021-06

Pursuant to the *Municipal Government Act,* notice is hereby given by that the Council of Town of Rainbow Lake public hearing before the second reading of Land Use Bylaw No. 2021-06. Land Use Bylaw No. 2021-06 proposes to replace the current Land Use Bylaw 2014-04, and enact the new Land Use Bylaw No. 2021-06.

The Land Use Bylaw (LUB) is a "rule book" that establishes the rules and regulations for development of land within the Town of Rainbow Lake. It also regulates the development of land and structures on a site-specific basis, based on the policy directions set by the statutory plans. It also includes what uses are appropriate on the land, where they may be located, and standards for those uses.

The public hearing will be held at the Town of Rainbow Lake Council Chambers on November 1, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. All residents are encouraged to review the new Land Use Bylaw and provide feedback before the Bylaw comes into effect.
