Property Taxes

The 2022 Property Taxation and Assessment notices for the Town of Rainbow Lake will be mailed out on May 6, 2022. If you are a property owner on the Assessment Roll for the Town of Rainbow Lake, you will be receiving a notice. If you don't receive your notice, or if your notice contains incorrect owner or mailing address information, please contact the Town Office and provide the correct information.

If you have any questions or concerns regarding the assessed value of your property, please contact the Town's Assessor Aaron Steblyk of Compass Assessment Cons Inc. at 780-469-5552 or by email at aron.steblyk@compassassessment.com

If speaking to the assessor does not resolve your concerns, you may appeal your assessment in writing pursuant to section 460 of the MGA.

Assessment complaint forms are available at the office as well as on the Municipal Affairs website https://www.alberta.ca/assets/documents/maproperty-assessment-compliance-review-form.pdf

On the complaint form, you MUST provide the reason(s) why you believe the information shown on the Assessment and Tax Notice is incorrect.

An Assessment Review Board hearing date will be set after the final complaint date.

Assessment complaint deadline is July 13, 2022.

The Online Auction will begin on June 9th with final bids closing at 8:00pm on June 14th. Please keep your eyes open for more information on Facebook closer to the date.




VET CLINIC
