In order to vote, you must produce identification for inspection. The identification must be one or more of the following as required by Section 53 of the *Local Authorities Election Act* or local bylaw:

- One piece of photo identification issued by a Canadian government or agency which includes the elector's name and current address (ie. Operator/Driver's License; Government Photo Identification Card (for non-driver's)); or
- One piece of identification authorized by the Chief Electoral Officer under the Election Act that establishes the elector's name and current address. (ie. Government cheque or cheque stub; property tax notice; insurance policy or coverage card; utility bill, etc.). - If a voter's identification shows a post office box number as the address instead of a residential or legal address, it can be accepted as verification of current address if it is in reasonable proximity to the voting jurisdiction.
