

EVACUATION PLAN FOR THE TOWN OF RAINBOW LAKE • MAY 4, 2023

Triggers have been set for evacuation due to either immediate threat from the wildfire or the compromise of our single point of egress. In the event one of these established triggers are met, being a change in fire direction and/or imminent threat posed to Highway 58, the Town will issue a mandatory evacuation order for the Town of Rainbow Lake.

If an evacuation order is given by the Town of Rainbow Lake, the following steps will be taken:

- 1. A notification will be sent out on the Town's Voyent Alert App and Facebook.
- 2. An Alberta Emergency Alert will be issued to everyone in the area, over phones, radios TV's etc.
- 3. The emergency air horn siren located at centre of Town will sound continuously every minute to alert residents it is time to leave.
- 4. Door to Door evacuation notification will be completed from Town Staff.
- 5. The evacuation and reception centre will be coordinated with G-Prep in the Grande Prairie area. This information will be provided with the Evacuation Order.
- 6. The Town has coordinated a school bus resource through the Fort Vermilion School Division to facilitate evacuation of residents without a vehicle. Any residents needing transportation should contact Danielle Bourgeois at 780-956-3934 ext 103 (office) or 902-317-1200 (cell) to preregister for pickup at the Recplex.
- 7. RCMP and Town staff will have a checkpoint close to the Chateh turn off to account for for all residents. Please be sure to bring your IDs to facilitate this check point and be prepared to slow down as you approach that section of Highway 58 for everyone's safety.

Please download the **Voyent Alert** app as that will be your best source of information and notification for the remainder of this emergency.
