




## Lego Program

# **Development Permits**

Just a reminder that our Land Use Bylaw requires development permits when there is a change of use to a parcel of land or if the footprint of the land changes . This means for all the mobile homes that are being sold and removed from parcels of land, we do need to have a development permit submitted to the Town Office. The permit is completely free and is used as backup to let our assessor know when the building was removed from the parcel of land. This will help ensure you receive an accurate Tax Assessment and Notice. If no paper work is filed, we have no backup to send to our assessor. This also helps to ensure that the water and gas meters are safely removed prior to the mobile home leaving town. ### **Cable Message**

Just a remined that Town Cable will no longer be available as of August 1, 2022. The Town will still be offering internet to all residents. We recommend that everyone has something setup before August 1, 2022 to ensure they don't lose their TV service. Some solutions that current cable customers can use are:

- SHAW Satellite
- Amazon Firestick (requires an internet connection)
- Roku (requires an internet connection)
- Apps on SMART TV
- Telus HUB

Some options you can utilize on a streaming device such as an Amazon Firestick or Roku are:

• River TV (this service offers 45 Channels and does have a guide and only cost \$16.99/month, the channels you will receive are shown below

• The Amazon Firestick and Roku do offer Netflix, Crave, Disney+, and Prime Video, Discovery+, Sportsnet, AMC+, Paramount+, and so much more. If you are currently a subscriber to any of these apps, you can sign in and have them all located on one device or if you are a new subscriber you can create an account to watch all of your favorite shows, you will just need an email address and credit card number  If you currently have an active Amazon account you are eligible for Amazon Prime Video. Amazon Prime Video does offer many channels that customers can utilize. Some examples are:

STACK TV is \$12.99/month and offers 13 channels (Global, HGTV Canada, Food Network Canada, W Network, Showcase, Slice, Adult Swim, National Geographic, The HISTORY<sup>®</sup> Channel, TELETOON, Treehouse, YTV, and the newly added Lifetime network) this service also comes with a guide as well

HOLLYWODO SUITE is \$4.99/month and offers a wide range of movies from the 70s-200s

NICK+ is \$5.99/month and offers a wide range of kid friendly shows and cartoons

• The only downfall will be that individuals who don't have an active service through a service provider (TELUS, Shaw, rogers, etc....) they wont be able to sign up to the GLOBAL App or the CTV App

For all the current customers who will be returning their cable equipment, you will not be charged a disconnect fee, this fee has been waived to accommodate the termination of cable. When you drop off your equipment, you will need to sign a disconnect form and inform the staff what you would like done with your deposit. You can have your deposit issued the following ways:

- Cheque (this will be issued at the next closest council meeting)
- Transferred to your Tax Account (if applicable)
- Transferred to any other active utility account
