

If speaking to the assessor does not resolve your concerns, you may appeal your assessment in writing pursuant to section 460 of the MGA. Assessment complaint forms are available at the office as well as on the Municipal Affairs website.

On the complaint form, you MUST provide reason(s) why you believe the information shown on the Assessment and Tax Notice is incorrect. An Assessment Review Board hearing date will be set after the final complaint date.

As of April 24, 2025 the wildfire danger level for the High Level Forest Area is listed as HIGH.

You can help prevent wildfires:

- Spread out the remaining woody debris.
- Scan the ashes by looking, smelling and carefully feeling with a bare hand for any signs of smoke or heat from the pile.
- Soak hot spots and stir until they're completely extinguished.
- Before, during and after operating off highway vehicles, remove debris from hot spots on the machine.

If you see smoke or flame in the forest and suspect it is a wildfire, call 310-FIRE(3473).
